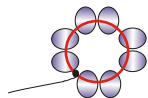


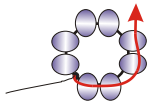


Simply Precious

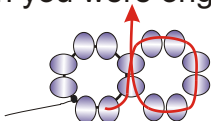
1. Thread a needle with 1-1/2yds of thread. Work with a single thread. String on (8) 15/0 seed beads. Push them down toward the end of your thread and tie them into a circle. Leave a 12" tail to use later.



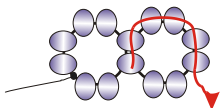
2. Relocate your thread by passing your needle thru (4) seed beads moving away from your knot.



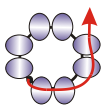
3. Pick up (6) new seed beads. Pass your needle thru the (2) seed beads you were originally coming out of going in the SAME direction you were originally going.



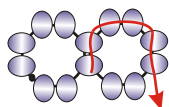
4. Relocate by passing your needle thru (4) seed beads without picking up any new beads.



5 Repeat steps 3 & 4 until you reach your desired length. Notice the "figure 8" flow of the thread. You will be going up thru the last two beads on one set and down the last two beads on the next set.

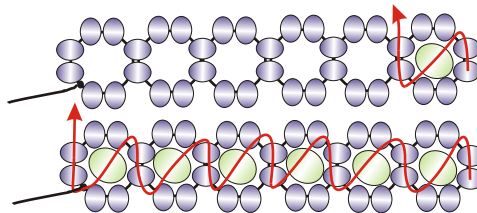


Thread going up

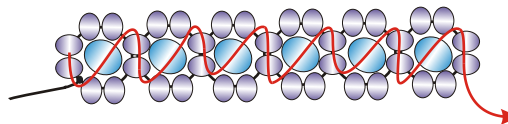


Thread going down

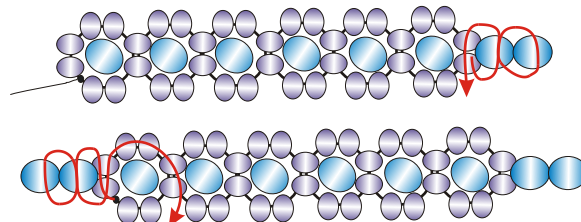
6. Embellish the center of each square with one 11/0 silver seed bead. Follow the path.



7. Flip your work over add one 11/0 to each square on the other side.



8. Square stitch 2 -11/0 seed beads to the end. As shown. Weave off your thread. Put a needle on the tail thread and do the same.



9. Mix the epoxy and drop a bit inside the bead cap. Wait a second or so until it gets a little sticky and then insert the (2) 11/0 seed beads inside the bead cap. Repeat on the other end. Let it dry. Attach the spring ring and Enjoy!
